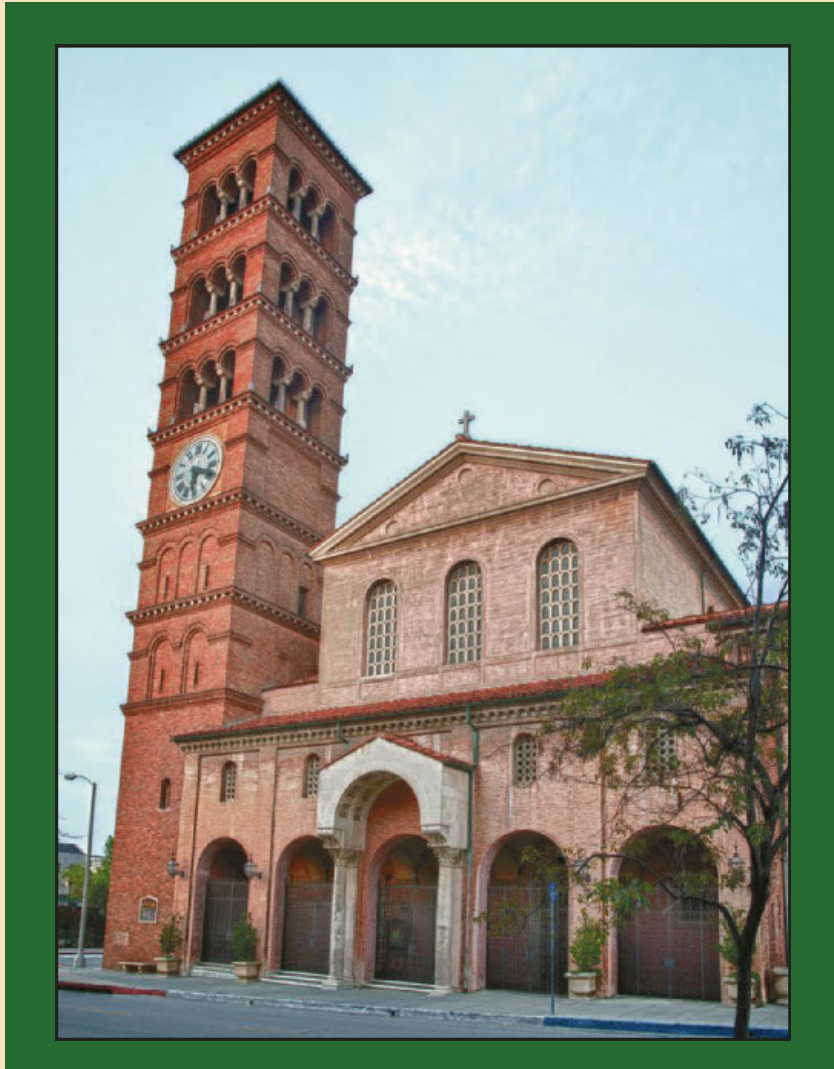

### Healing Gardens for victims-survivors in the Archdiocese's five pastoral regions

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles has created gardens of healing in each of the Archdiocese's pastoral regions, dedicated to those harmed by sexual abuse, in their family, church or community. Located at St. Camillus Pastoral Center in Los Angeles (Our Lady of Los Angeles Pastoral Region), Our Lady of the Assumption Parish in Ventura (Santa Barbara Pastoral Region) St. Francis de Sales Parish, Sherman Oaks (San Fernando Pastoral Region), and St. Bernadette Parish, Los Angeles (San Gabriel Pastoral Region), these gardens offer a sacred space for all those impacted by abuse to seek comfort and solace. A fifth garden will be built in the San Pedro Pastoral Region. In each garden there is a weeping wall and a plaque with a reflection by Archbishop Gomez, which starts with this paragraph: "Dedicated to all those impacted by sexual abuse in the Church, their communities, their families – may all who visit find some measure of renewal, peace and comfort in doing so." From September 2023 to May 2024, the arm of Saint Jude Thaddeus, venerated in Rome from ancient times, will be on pilgrimage in the United States, making stops in 100 cities.

## FROM THE MUSIC DIRECTOR

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

APRIL 28, 2024

### INTROIT

*Cantate Domino canticum novum, alleluia: quia mirabilia fecit Dominus, alleluia: ante conspectum gentium revelavit iustitiam suam, alleluia, alleluia.*

*Ps. Salvavit sibi dextera eius: et brachium sanctum eius.*

*Sing a new song to the LORD, alleluia; for he has done marvelous deeds, alleluia: in the sight of the nations he has revealed his justice, alleluia, alleluia.*

*Psalm verse: His right hand and holy arm have won the victory.*

### MUSIC IN THE LITURGY

“Sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done wondrous things! In the sight of the nations he has revealed his justice. His right hand and holy arm brought victory!” So reads the *Introit* to today’s Mass. Overcome with paschal joy, every land and every people exults in God’s praise. In the celebration of the Mass, we join with the heavenly Powers, with the angelic hosts, to sing together the unending hymn of God’s glory. And we, in the midst of a world seemingly turned upside and run by the enemy, we nevertheless rely on our God, who has done wondrous—marvelous—things, and in which we place our whole trust for deliverance.

### MUSIC AT SAINT ANDREW CONCERT SERIES

This past month, we have gotten a good taste of the great things to come at Saint Andrew Church! Two Sundays ago, the world-famous **Jordi Savall and Hespèrion XXI**, in their fiftieth year of performance, presented a sublime concert at Saint Andrew Church. The concert sold out and we had visitors from San Diego, San Francisco, and even one from Canada in attendance!

On **Saturday, May 18, 2024 at 7:30 pm**, **Pueri Cantores San Gabriel Valley** will present another magnificent concert with choir, orchestra, and soloists under the masterful direction of Mr. Patrick Flahive, school music teacher and director of our burgeoning children’s choir school.

### MUSIC IN THE LITURGY

We return to the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM). Recall, it can be found at [www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/the-mass/general-instruction-of-the-roman-missal/](http://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/the-mass/general-instruction-of-the-roman-missal/).

The *General Instruction*, the rule which governs the celebration of the Mass, “the center of the whole of Christian life for the Church both universal and local,” makes clear that the entirety of Christian life is “bound up with it, flow from it, and are ordered to it.” This shows the importance of our preparation: our work is bound up with the source and summit of our very existence!

The *General Instruction* gives detailed instruction for each portion of the Mass. The musical parts may be divided into movements with texts that never (or almost never) change, and those parts with text that changes according to the liturgical day. The texts that never change are called the *Ordinary* (from the Latin word *ordinarius*, meaning “regular,” “usual,” or “customary”) of the Mass, while the texts that change for each liturgical day are called the *Proper* (from the Latin term *proprius*, meaning “particular,” “characteristic [of something],” or “[one’s] own”) of the Mass.

The parts of the *Ordinary* of the Mass sung by the choir and congregation include the Kyrie, Gloria, Creed, Sanctus, Memorial Acclamation, Our Father, and Agnus Dei. The texts of these movements do not change throughout the year, though the Gloria is omitted during non-feast and non-solemnity days during Lent and Advent. These parts of the Mass were historically the last to be relinquished by the congregation, and are most of these movements are normatively sung by the congregation.

The parts of the *Proper* sung by choir and congregation include the Introit (entrance chant), Gradual (or Responsorial Psalm), the Gospel Acclamation (normally “alleluia,” but replaced by a different text from Ash Wednesday through Good Friday), the Offertory chant, and the Communion chant. These parts are given specific texts for each liturgical day and were traditionally the purview of the *schola cantorum*, or choir. Today, the *General Instruction* clarifies the role of all of the Propers and Ordinary of the Mass. Next week, we will begin to examine what the *General Instruction* has to say about each, as found in Chapter II, *The Structure of the Mass, Its Elements, and Its Parts*.

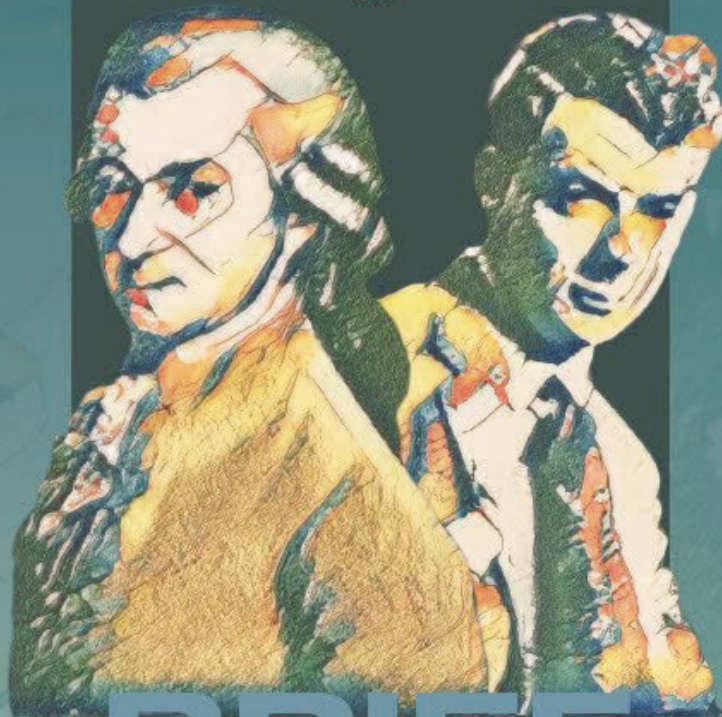

### MÚSICA EN LA LITURGIA

“¡Cantad al Señor un cántico nuevo, porque ha hecho maravillas! A la vista de las naciones ha revelado su justicia. ¡Su mano derecha y su brazo santo trajeron la victoria! Así reza el Introito de la Misa de hoy. Invidiosos por la alegría pascual, cada tierra y cada pueblo se exultan en la alabanza de Dios. En la celebración de la Misa, nos unimos a los Poderes celestiales, a las huestes angelicales, para cantar juntos el himno interminable de la gloria de Dios. Y nosotros, en medio de un mundo aparentemente trastornado y gobernado por el enemigo, confiamos sin embargo en nuestro Dios, quien ha hecho cosas maravillosas, maravillosas, y en quien depositamos toda nuestra confianza para la liberación.

### CICLO DE CONCIERTOS DE MÚSICA EN SAN ANDRÉS

¡El mes pasado, pudimos probar las grandes cosas que vendrán en la Iglesia de San Andrés! Hace dos domingos, los mundialmente famosos **Jordi Savall y Hespèrion XXI**, en su quincuagésimo año de actuación, ofrecieron un concierto sublime en la iglesia de San Andrés. ¡El concierto se agotó y asistieron visitantes de San Diego, San Francisco e incluso uno de Canadá!

**El sábado 18 de mayo de 2024 a las 7:30 pm, Pueri Cantores San Gabriel Valley** presentará otro magnífico concierto con coro, orquesta y solistas bajo la magistral dirección del Sr. Patrick Flahive, maestro de música de la escuela y director de nuestro floreciente coro de niños. escuela.

### MÚSICA EN LA LITURGIA

Volvemos a la *Instrucción General del Misal Romano* (IGMR). Recuerde, se puede encontrar en [www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/the-mass/general-instruction-of-the-roman-missal/](http://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/the-mass/general-instruction-of-the-roman-missal/).

*La Instrucción General*, regla que rige la celebración de la Misa, “centro de toda la vida cristiana para la Iglesia universal y local”, deja claro que toda la vida cristiana está “ligada a ella, fluye de ella”. , y se les ordena hacerlo ”.

Esto muestra la importancia de nuestra preparación: ¡nuestro trabajo está ligado a la fuente y cumbre de nuestra existencia misma!

*La Instrucción General* da instrucciones detalladas para cada parte de la Misa. Las partes musicales se pueden dividir en movimientos con textos que nunca (o casi nunca) cambian, y aquellas partes con texto que cambia según el día litúrgico. Los textos que nunca cambian se llaman *Ordinarios* (de la palabra latina *ordinarius*, que significa “regular”, “habitual” o “habitual”) de la Misa, mientras que los textos que cambian para cada día litúrgico se llaman *Propio* (de la Término latino *proprius*, que significa “particular”, “característica [de algo]” o “propio”) de la Misa.

Las partes del *Ordinario* de la Misa cantadas por el coro y la congregación incluyen Kyrie, Gloria, Credo, Sanctus, Aclamación Conmemorativa, Padre Nuestro y Agnus Dei. Los textos de estos movimientos no cambian a lo largo del año, aunque el Gloria se omite durante los días no festivos ni solemnes durante la Cuaresma y el Adviento. Estas partes de la Misa fueron históricamente las últimas en ser abandonadas por la congregación, y la mayoría de estos movimientos son cantados normativamente por la congregación.

Las partes del *Propio* cantadas por el coro y la congregación incluyen el Introito (canto de entrada), el Gradual (o Salmo Responsorial), la Aclamación del Evangelio (normalmente “aleluya”, pero reemplazado por un texto diferente desde el Miércoles de Ceniza hasta el Viernes Santo), el Ofertorio. canto y el canto de Comunión. Estas partes reciben textos específicos para cada día litúrgico y tradicionalmente eran competencia de la *schola cantorum* o coro. Hoy, la *Instrucción General* aclara el papel de todos los Propios y Ordinarios de la Misa. La próxima semana, comenzaremos a examinar lo que la *Instrucción General* tiene que decir sobre cada uno, como se encuentra en el Capítulo II, *La Estructura de la Misa, Su Elementos y sus partes*.

### Jardines de sanación para víctimas-sobrevivientes de las cinco regiones de la Arquidiócesis

La Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles ha creado jardines de sanación en cada una de las regiones pastorales de la Arquidiócesis, dedicados a aquellos perjudicados por el abuso sexual, en su familia, iglesia o comunidad. Ubicados en el Centro Pastoral San Camilo en Los Ángeles (Región Pastoral Nuestra Señora de Los Ángeles), Parroquia Nuestra Señora de la Asunción en Ventura (Región Pastoral de Santa Bárbara), Parroquia San Francisco de Sales en Sherman Oaks (Región Pastoral de San Fernando) y Parroquia Santa Bernadette en Los Ángeles (Región Pastoral San Gabriel), estos jardines ofrecen un espacio sagrado para que todos aquellos afectados por el abuso busquen consuelo.
