

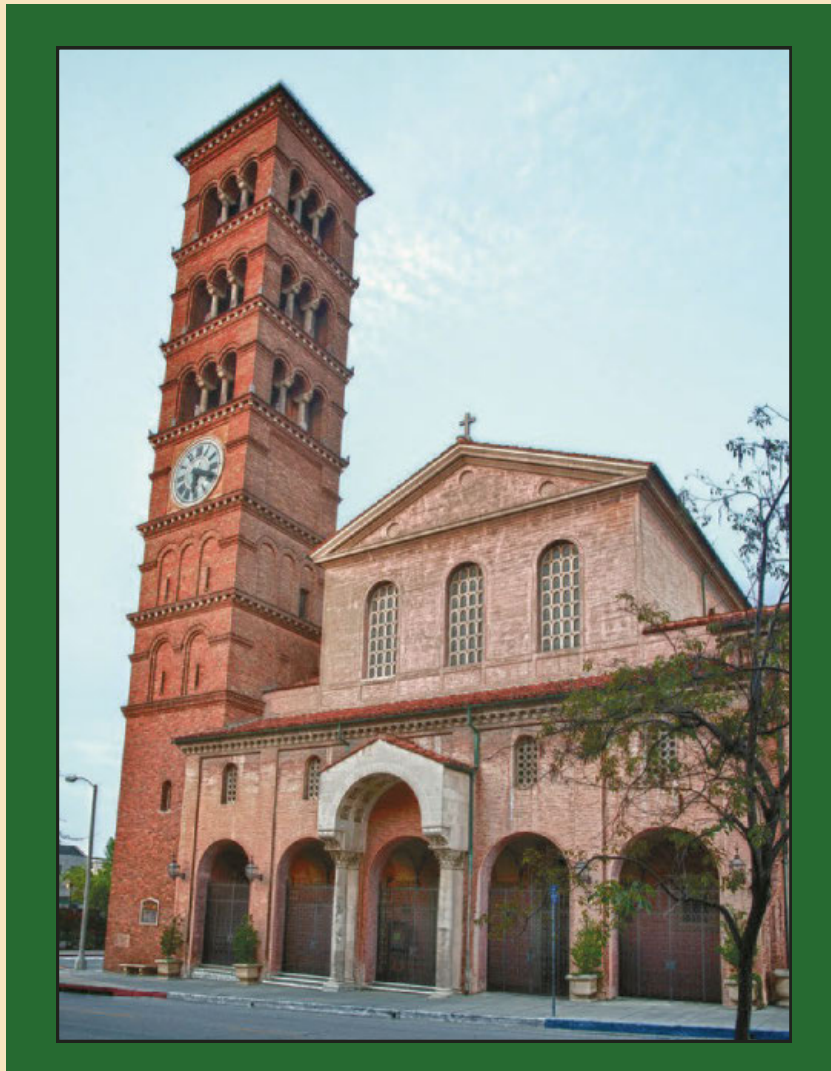

RELICS OF ST. JUDE COMING TO ST. ANDREW'S – Our parish is honored to have been chosen to host the relics of the Apostle St. Jude next month. From September 2023 to May 2024, the arm of Saint Jude Thaddeus, venerated in Rome from ancient times, will be on pilgrimage in the United States, making stops in 100 cities. One of the Church's most beloved saints, Saint Jude, is the one to whom people turn when they are desperate and have tried everything else. When things seem lost or unbearable—when they seem hopeless—Saint Jude is the one to whom people often turn.

Come and experience his transformative presence. Come and see what he has for you. The schedule is as follows:

Friday, May 10, 2024 – Relics are exhibited beginning at 2:00 p.m. and continue all afternoon. Solemn Mass will take place at 6:30 p.m. which includes a homily on St. Jude. Veneration of the relics then continues until 10:00 p.m.

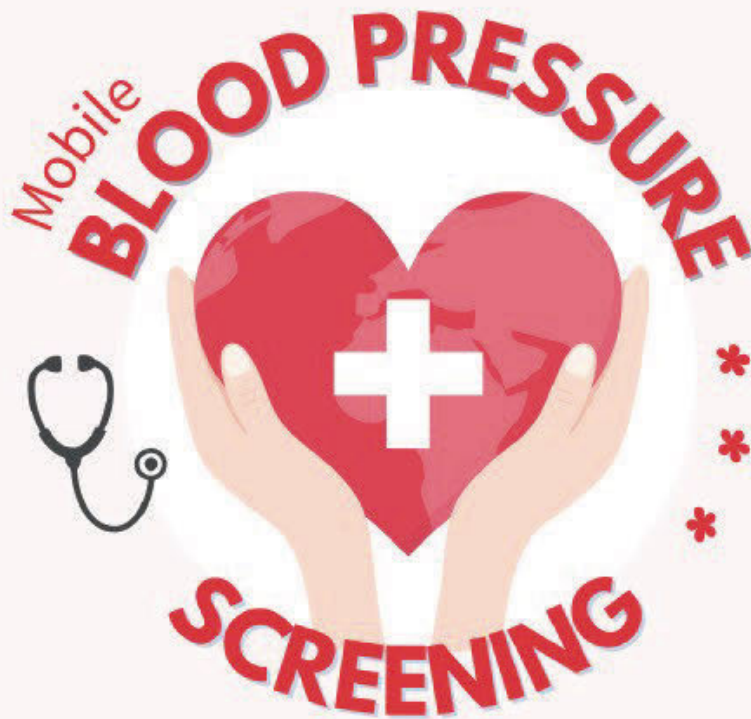

MUSIC AT SAINT ANDREW CONCERT SERIES

I want to start by sharing my gratitude for the stunning success of last Sunday's concert by Maestro Jordi Savall & Hespèrion XXI. We offered him a full house of enthusiastic fans, many of whom came from great distances to attend. Dozens came from the San Diego metro area and nearly a dozen from the San Francisco Bay Area, having missed out their chance to see M. Savall there because their venue—in Berkeley—sold out. We even had one person all the way from Canada!

I spoke with Maestro Savall and members of Hespèrion XXI individually and they were of one mind that the hospitality, the loving care of the staff and volunteers, and the joy and enthusiasm of our audience were the best of their tour, and that Saint Andrew Church represented a world-class venue. I know they are very happy, even anxious, to return.

I am so very grateful to all here, first of all to Fr. Gonzalez for supporting the idea of creating a world-class music program, which includes a world-class concert series, Music at Saint Andrew, and to our esteemed Concert Committee chair, Jerilyn Castillo McAniff, who brought great expertise and leadership to our preparation. My gratitude to all who supported this endeavor with their generous volunteering and with their attendance! All your hard and extraordinary work has helped to put Saint Andrew Church and Old Pasadena on the map in the world of Early Music and, with our hosting of the Tallis Scholars in years past and in years to come, in the world of choral music.

MUSIC IN THE LITURGY

The image of the Good Shepherd stands out prominently in today's readings, particularly the Gospel. The entrance hymn today speaks to this, and reminds us the comfort of our faith: "In heavenly love abiding, No change my heart shall fear; And safe is such confiding, For nothing changes here: The storm may roar without me, My heart may low be laid; But God is round about me; How can I be dismayed?"

Indeed how can we be dismayed, if we have faith? The extended stress of life can seem intolerable; but there is one who knows our sorrow and has walked with us. He is with us now, to welcome us to the holy Sacrifice of the Mass every week. [It is, then, in faith—and with hope born of the experience of salvation—that we can pray the last verse of our entrance hymn: "Green pastures are before me which yet I have not seen; Bright skies will soon be o'er me, Where darkest clouds have been. My hope I cannot measure, The path to life is free; My Savior has my treasure, And he will walk with me."
